Vestry Highlights March 15, 2018

- The Vestry discussed and agreed to partner with BPW (Business and Professional Women) to hold a Community Conversation about Addiction in May.
- We will continue to work on Position Descriptions for our staff.
- In order to accommodate Bible study on Tuesday evenings, Vestry will meet on the second Thursday of the month.
- The Vestry agreed by email to accept the Parochial Report with the addition of our capital funds and savings in the financial report. The report was forwarded to the Diocese.
- We are seeking permission from the Diocese to sign a gas lease with Cabot for our .71 acres. Lynne will present the lease to the Standing Committee at their meeting on March 21.
- We would like to purchase round tables for the parish hall, but need to verify size vs. cost as we have a wide discrepancy in our estimates.
- The altar silver has been refurbished and returned to church. We approved spending \$1105 from the memorial fund to send brass pieces (offering plates, cover for baptismal font, and several more) to Charles and Mary in Duryea for repair and refurbishing after Easter.
- We agreed to hold a luncheon on the Sunday of Artists' Tour Weekend as a fundraiser for bread for the Mobile Food Pantry.

 We will ask Kurt Sussman to discuss with the Vestry the idea of a promotional video of St. Paul's.
