Vestry Highlights, January 9, 2020

- We read John 8:12-19 and discussed how Jesus spoke to the Pharisees with confidence that he had the testimony of himself and God.
- Fr. Arthur reported that he is working with community leadership, the Chamber of Commerce, the Diocese and social media to get St. Paul's name out there. He reads the daily offices and has been livestreaming them on his Facebook page. These will also be coordinated with St. Paul's Facebook page.
- The Vestry worked on the Easter schedule in coordination with St. Mark's. On Ash Wednesday we will offer "driveby" ashes and a bag lunch. The Ash Wednesday service will be held at St. Mark's. We will have our Palm Sunday service at 1 p.m. on Sunday rather than our first weekend of the month Saturday service. Easter Vigil will be at St. Mark's and we will have our regular Easter service at 10 a.m.
- The Episcopal Parishes of Upper Susquehanna County received a grant of \$7500 from the Eli Lilly Foundation. This was matched by the Diocese. We have submitted a second grant proposal for Congregational Development.

- We will establish a Mutual Ministry Council at St. Paul's with Arthur and 3 parish members.
- The Vestry nominated John Warriner to replace Maggie Sock as a Vestry member. This will be voted on at the Annual Meeting.
- The Vestry authorized Arthur to begin working with a company on creating a logo for St. Paul's and the EPUSC.
- The Vestry voted to distribute the Country Store proceeds to the Lunch Box Program (an extension of the Montrose Mobile Food Pantry) and to Interfaith to help with heat bills.
- We approved our 2020 budget including the full assessment and acceptance to the Diocese. The budget includes a salary for a Director of Communications position for about 4 hours/week. We reviewed and accepted the Treasurer's Report.
